- Filming is due to start soon



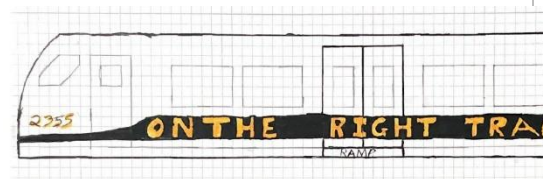
E-Learning

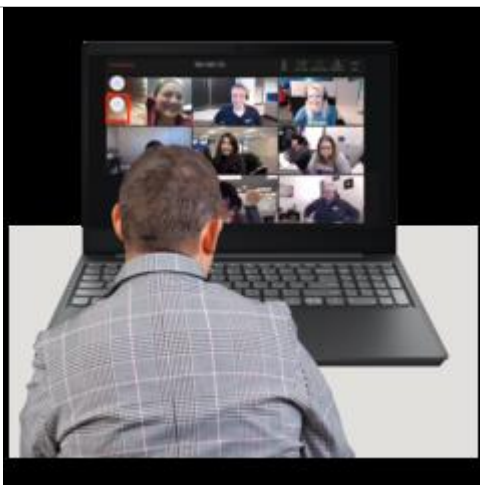
Projection Equipment
