- We want to thank everyone who helps us



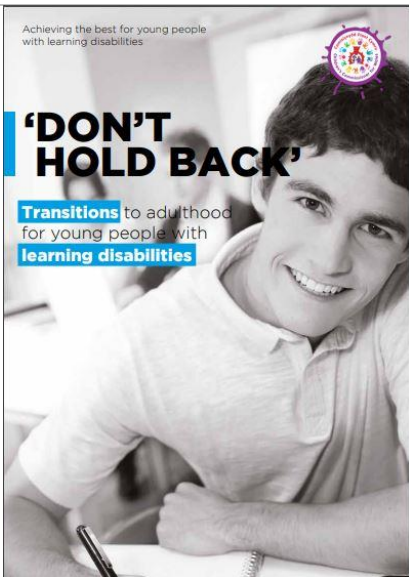
Dancing for Children in Conwy
